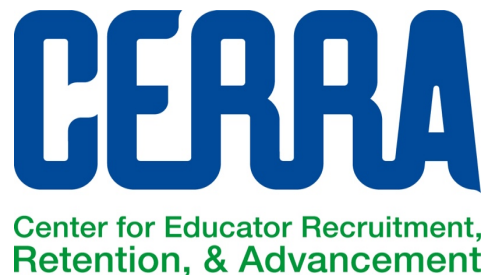


The Ken Bower Teacher Cadet Scholarship
